### ***What Sets Theophany School Apart***

Life at Theophany School allows our children to participate in a faith-based education where their individual strengths are cultivated, fostering independent learning. We strive to educate our children in the same way the Church educates the members of its body: by engaging the senses, enlightening the mind, and nurturing the spirit.

- *Engage the senses* Our experience in our life in Faith is not static. It incorporates the smell of incense, the taste of Communion, the stories seen in icons and the movements and music of prayer. At Theophany School, children use their senses to experience and experiment with the world around them, making connections and encouraging lifelong exploration in the process.
- *Enlighten the mind* At Theophany School, our classrooms are set up strategically to encourage our students to explore materials and curriculum at their own pace. Small class sizes allow educators to cater each lesson to the strengths of each child individually, as well as provide ample opportunities for one-on-one intervention to fortify each student's weaknesses. Our expectations and our curriculum ensure that students meet or exceed Massachusetts State Frameworks. We encourage our children to soar!
- *Nurture the spirit* Our educators know that strengthening the spirit takes work. Our mission at Theophany School is to challenge our students to grow spiritually through prayer, good works, Liturgical life, and developing Christian relationships with the world around them. Our focus on relationships fosters open, thoughtful communication, respect for all of God's creation, forgiveness, and humility. We strive to meet each child and family on their individual spiritual path, kindling their relationships with Christ and with each other.
