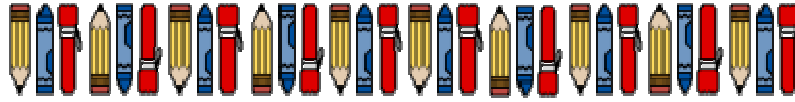


Ms. Elizabeth's classroom Newsletter.
